



INTRODUCTION




God's love toward us


Repent and be saved


Christ had a vision of reaching souls and bringing them back home. This was truly demonstrated when He wept over a particular city.

God.


The Gift of God

ANSWER

One of the Bible's greatest truths is that God offers us our salvation as a free gift. It isn't something we can buy, nor is it something we can earn by our own good works. The Bible puts it this way: "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 6:23).

SUPPOSE YOU WANTED TO EXPRESS YOUR LOVE FOR SOMEONE BY GIVING THEM A VERY FINE GIFT. WHAT WOULD YOU HAVE TO DO? WELL, YOU'D FIRST HAVE TO GO TO THE STORE AND BUY IT—AND THE FINER THE GIFT, THE MORE IT WOULD COST YOU. TO YOUR FRIEND, IT'S A FREE GIFT, BUT IT WASN'T FREE ON YOUR PART.






THE SAME IS TRUE WITH GOD'S GIFT OF SALVATION. TO US IT'S FREE, BUT IT COST GOD THE LIFE OF HIS SON. THE REASON IS BECAUSE ON THE CROSS JESUS CHRIST BECAME THE FINAL SACRIFICE FOR OUR SINS. HE PAID FOR OUR SALVATION WITH HIS BLOOD.








If there is faith for salvation there is faith for miracles!


Kenneth E. Hagin made this profound statement.


What is faith?


Someone once asked Raymond T. Richey, a man mightily used of God in the healing ministry, "What is faith?" Richey replied, "faith is just acting on God's word".




